

Profile of MRH residents taken from STATUS survey 2006

The profile of MRH's residents reflects the rural nature of the homes it manages and is, to some extent, influenced by its locally determined lettings policies that include local connection as a factor for consideration.

MRH carried out a resident survey in 2006 from which it found that:

- 8% of respondents are permanently sick or disabled.
- From the 265 respondents:
 - 256 were White British; (96.6%)
 - 1 Indian;
 - 1 White/Black Caribbean,
 - 1 White Spanish
 - and 6 did not answer.

The East Midlands is the third most rural region in England with 29.5% of the population living in rural settlements (population of <10,000).¹
