Gender

34% of respondents to the survey are male whilst 63% are female and 3% did not provide details of their gender.

Age

One quarter (25%) are aged 65 or over, approaching half (46%) are aged 35-64 and 27% are aged between 16 and 34. The remaining did not disclose their age.

Long standing illness, disability or infirmity and wheelchair use

Overall, 39% state that they, or someone else in their household, has a long standing illness, disability or infirmity. This is highest amongst households in which the respondent is aged 45-64 (56%) and 65+ (56%).

7% state that someone in their household uses a wheelchair.
